

## Borrow and Return

Borrowing and return can be done via Self-check Machines or Service Counters.

<u>SearchPlus</u> is a one-stop search tool that helps you quickly find the resources you want. You can use it to search for both print and e-resources: books, e-books, journal articles, multimedia materials, and other digital objects.

# Study Space

8 <u>Self Study Rooms</u> are available for private study. Each room can be reserved for once per day for a two-hour session.

# Collaborative Space

10 <u>Group Discussion Rooms</u> and 1 <u>Postgraduate Study Room</u> are available for your collaborative learning. Each room can be reserved one per day for a two-hour session.

## **Computer Workstations**
