

When the Library is closed, Library items (except Course Reserve Collection and Multimedia Collection) can be returned to Book Drop outside G/F of the Library.






## Searching and Locating Materials

#### Search Resources

<u>OneSearch</u> is a one-stop search tool that helps you quickly find the resources you want. You can use it to search for both print and e-resources: books, e-books, journal articles, multimedia materials, newspapers, and other digital objects.

#### Books and Items On-site



• The Library uses the Library of Congress (LC) Classification Scheme to arrange all materials. Every item is assigned a call number.

#### Access Resources at Other University Libraries

You can <u>request a library card</u> to access HKU Libraries (for final year students only), CUHK Library, HKSYU Library, HKBU Library, EdUHK Library, HKAPA Library, SFU Library, TWC Library, and use physical and electronic resources on-site.

## **Space and Facilities**

#### Study Space

<u>Self Study Rooms</u> and a <u>Barrier-free Self Study Room</u> are available for private study. Each room can be reserved once per day for a two-hour session.





## Collaborative Space

<u>Group Discussion Rooms</u> and a <u>Postgraduate Study Room</u> are available for your collaborative learning. Each room can be reserved once per day for a two-hour session.

## Study Cube

<u>Study Cube</u> is a soundproof booth that offers a quiet and private study area, ideal for online interviews and classes. Different types of Study Cubes are available, with capacities for 1 person and for 2 to 4 people. Each room can be reserved once per day for a two-hour session.





#### Computer Workstations

Computers are available on every floor of the Library, with some workstations equipped with frequently used software like Microsoft Office and SPSS. All iMacs are installed with the Apple Pro Apps Bundle for Education, while some have Adobe Creative Cloud, which includes Acrobat, Illustrator, Photoshop, Premiere Pro, and more.

#### Photocopying and Scanning

All-In-One printers are available on every floor of the Library. You can print, copy, and scan document with your student card.



#### Digital Equipment Loan Services/Self Service Locker

You can borrow Digital Equipment including iPads, MacBooks, cameras, and camcorders at the Library G/F service counter.

You can also reserve books online and pick them up anytime from the self-service locker on the 2/F of S H Ho Academic Building, even at night, on weekends, or public holidays.





#### Media Creative Space

Located on 2/F of the Library, the Media Creative Space contains a space for media production. Besides, students are welcome to borrow equipment for media production at the Service Counter on 2/F of the Library.

# **Learning Support Services**

#### Subject Guides

<u>Subject Guides</u> are good starting points for your study. They contain recommended resources and provide tips on searching related to specific subjects and topics.





#### Information Skills Workshops

The Library organises a series of <u>workshops</u> to help students to sharpen their information skills. Topics include finding resources of different subject areas, using citation management tools, making a professional presentation, etc. Students can earn iGPS unit(s) upon completion of each workshop.

#### Reference and Information Services

Library staff are pleased to offer help in using Library services and resources. You can <u>reserve a time slot</u> with Learning Support Librarians for an indepth consultation session. The librarians can assist you in making use of specific electronic databases, locating relevant literature for your assignment, and evaluating resources for your project needs. Both individuals and small groups are welcome.
